

## **SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL** **MID-YEAR ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

The Riley School Community Council met on December 18<sup>th</sup> to discuss some of our council's accomplishments thus far this school year. Here is a list of what we have accomplished:

- families are feeling comfortable at Riley
- attendance at SCC has improved
- we are doing fundraisers including a recipe book and a movie night
- we have sponsored a charitable fundraiser for the victims of Hurricane Harvey in Texas
- we have advocated for changes in some of the traffic rules surrounding Riley, including a school light on California Avenue and changes to the walking route so children don't have to cross so many streets.
- we have looked at and discussed student data, including how to improve student outcomes moving forward. This has involved reviewing the School Improvement Plan, Land Trust Plan, and 90-day plan and discussing how best to address some of our school needs.
- we have discussed student incentives and how to keep students engaged in positive behaviors. As a result of SCC advocacy, teachers were awarded with an additional \$100 to buy classroom incentives for positive behavior.
- we have gotten a Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) going.
