Dear Families,

Halloween is coming. It is a Monday this year!

We will have a regular school day on Halloween. Students should come to school in school uniform. They may bring their costumes if they would like to change into them after lunch.

This year, we are trying something a little new during Halloween. Teachers have prepared a short presentation by the students in their classes. We would love parents to come to classes to watch the presentations before and/or after the parade.
